

## MVM GROUP ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The mission of the MVM Group, as a key player in the Hungarian and Eastern-European energy industry, is to guarantee the security of the area's energy supply and of the public utility services for which it is responsible, to increase the satisfaction of its customers, and to use renewable energy sources as widely as possible, while minimising the burden it places on the environment. Its activities include electricity production, transportation, distribution and trade; independent transmission network control; transmission and distribution network development, operation, and maintenance; natural gas trade, distribution and storage; power plant development and operation; energy services to industrial companies; district heating services; IT, financial, accounting, security, engineering and logistics services, and the uniform, central control of the national public utility services system, the development and the long-term and sustainable operation of public utility services of the state in the natural gas, electricity and district heating sectors.

The activities of the MVM Group inevitably affect the state of the natural and built environment. Taking ownership of the basic principles of sustainability and taking the lifecycle approach into account, the MVM Group aims at minimising the impacts on environment elements and ecological systems, reducing harmful emissions, eliminating any earlier environmental damage, and applying the basic principles of prudence and responsibility.

The MVM Group strives to develop efficient and sustainable procedures and technologies by building on the long-term innovation and decarbonisation approach set out in its strategy and ESG strategy, thus strengthening its customer focus, competitiveness, market position and reputation. - apply the greatest care in regenerating abandoned sites and making the areas fit for re-use;
- in line with international expectations and in order to increase transparency, define and publish new trackable indicators of sustainability performance in the ESG framework;
- regularly inform its interested parties in its sustainability performance report (Integrated ESG Report);
- continuously improve the professional competencies of its employees and partners and ensure the strengthening of their commitment to the sustainable economy and to environmental protection as well as their environmental awareness;
- enter into continuous dialogue with stakeholders, and cooperate with administrative bodies with a view to preventing and eliminating environmental pollution and hazardous situations;
- take part in civil society initiatives aimed at environmental protection and sustainability;
- support the implementation, operation and continuous development of an environmental management system at its Companies.

The MVM Group regularly reviews compliance with its environmental policy and based on the evaluations, continuously strives for improvement, and it also makes its environmental policy available for everyone on its website. The group-level environmental policy applies to all members of the company group.
